## Installing Flash Player for Android

## **Install Dolphin Web browser**

1. Download and install the Dolphin web browser from Play Store.



- 2. Start the application
- 3. Go to settings and set "Flash Player" to "always on"

- 5. Go to the device's security settings (accessible from the main / home screen) and set permissions to allow installation of applications from unknown sources (see sample screenshots on next page).



 Launch again the Dolphin browser and go to <u>"https://dolphin.com/lab/en/</u>", download and install the Flash Player. Scroll down until you find the link for Flash Player, which please download and install:
